



What does a Volunteer do?

Volunteers are needed to assist with a variety of things:

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Hill County offers daily educational, recreational, social and cultural enrichment programs and activities for youth ages 6-18. Our location services 130 youth each day. Our building centered philosophy allows the club to provide accessible safe havens to youth to help them with school, preparation for college and especially, life.

Volunteers could assist with:

Reading to Youth

Many of our children are eager to read aloud and show off their talents, some need help improving their reading skills, while others just want to hear a good story. You can be the one to make a difference by spending some time reading with a child in our education room.

Tutoring Youth

Caring adults are needed on a weekly basis to spend time with youth who are struggling academically. Youth in our tutoring program range from age 6 to 18 and you can be matched with an age that you feel most comfortable. Tutoring takes place during the academic year between the hours of 3:00 pm -6:00 pm.

Homework Helpers

Join us during Power Hour™ as a homework helper! Power Hour™ takes place during the academic year between the hours of 3:00 pm – 5:00 pm. As a homework helper, you can assist our Club members with their homework, check their work when they are finished and help to track their Power Points.

Help with a Reading is Fundamental Book Distribution

Volunteers are needed to help distribute books five times per year with our Reading is Fundamental Program. All Club members are given the opportunity to choose a free book at the themed distribution events. Distribution dates and times will be announced. If you are interested in setting up a themed event for our book distribution, let us know!

Volunteer Coach

Volunteers are needed to coach youth in various sports throughout the year. You can help youth develop sportsmanship and leadership skills while developing their athletic skills. Opportunities are also available for those interested in volunteering as a referee or scorekeeper.

Journalism Club

Volunteers are needed to teach the principles of journalism speak to our youth about journalism as a career and / or assist them in developing the club newspaper. The journalism Club will meet weekly to produce a monthly newspaper. Special curriculum is provided by Newspapers in Education.

Arts and Crafts projects

Volunteers are needed to assist with arts and crafts projects in the cultural enrichment room. Do you have a special talent like cake decorating, sewing or purse making, that you would like to share with our youth? Let us know.

Cultural Presentations

Do you want to share your culture with our Club members? We need volunteers to teach our youth to dance, play chess, learn about music, host a poetry slam or share a travel experience. Let us know if you would like to set up a special cultural event or class at our club.

Community Service

Help engage our Club members in a community service project. Assist them with planning and executing a service project in our community.



How to I become a volunteer?

Steps to Becoming a Volunteer:

1. You must complete a volunteer opportunity form, which includes a volunteer inquiry form. You will also need to submit a copy of your driver's license or valid ID. Applications are available at the club office or the from a board member.
2. Once you fill out your volunteer opportunity form, please submit it to the club office via email or by dropping it off.
3. We will then review the application and complete a background check.
4. Upon return of a clear background check, we will schedule a volunteer interview and orientation (at your convenience) at our club office.
5. After that, you will be assigned a group of children to work with.
